He was 17 when he went to New York, to stay with his father and stepmother, Shirley Jones, who were co-starring on Broadway in a musical, "Maggie Flynn". David barely had time to struggle or edge a job as a garment district stock boy into his history before Ruth Aarons, personal manager to Jack and Shirley and longtime family friend, had him audition for a featured role in a Broadway-bound musical, "The Fig Leaves Are Falling". He got the role and, subsequently, better reviews than the show, which expired after three performances.
