His beautiful white house on the hill is just such a place...

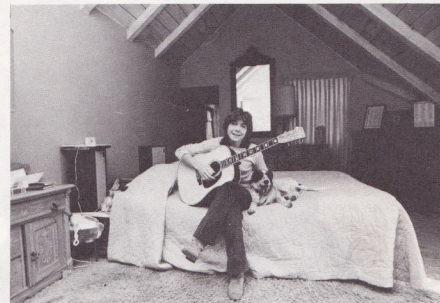
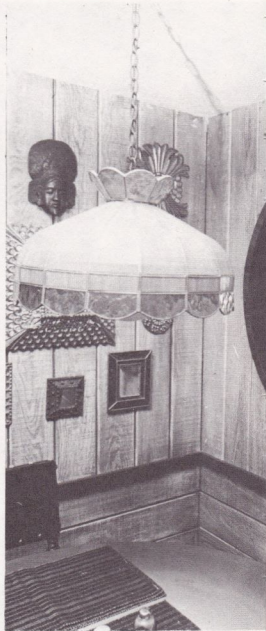
