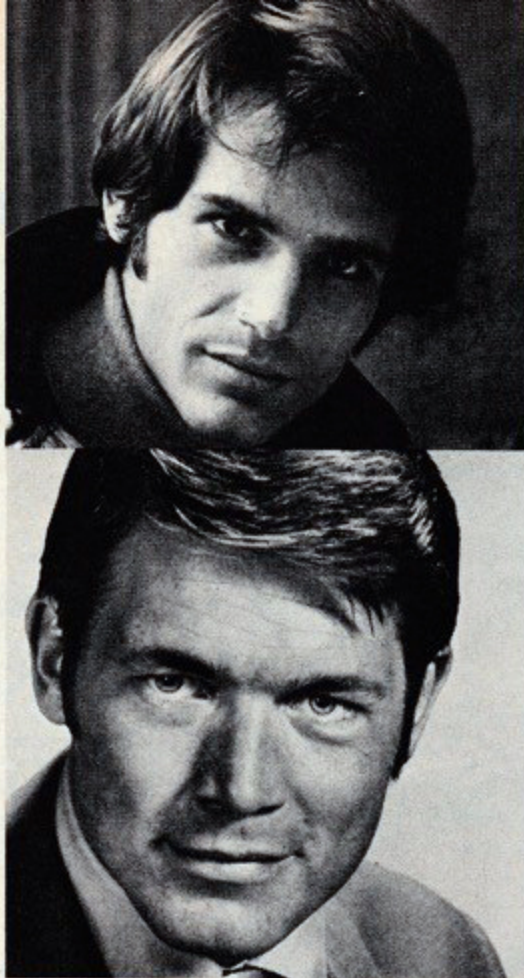


TELEVISION
