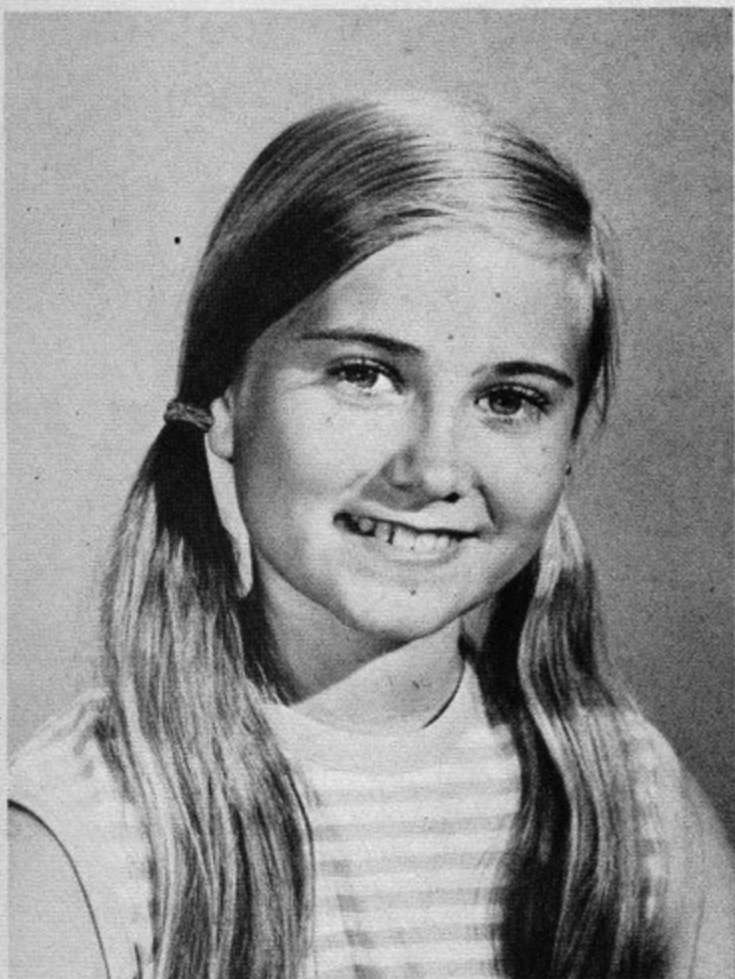
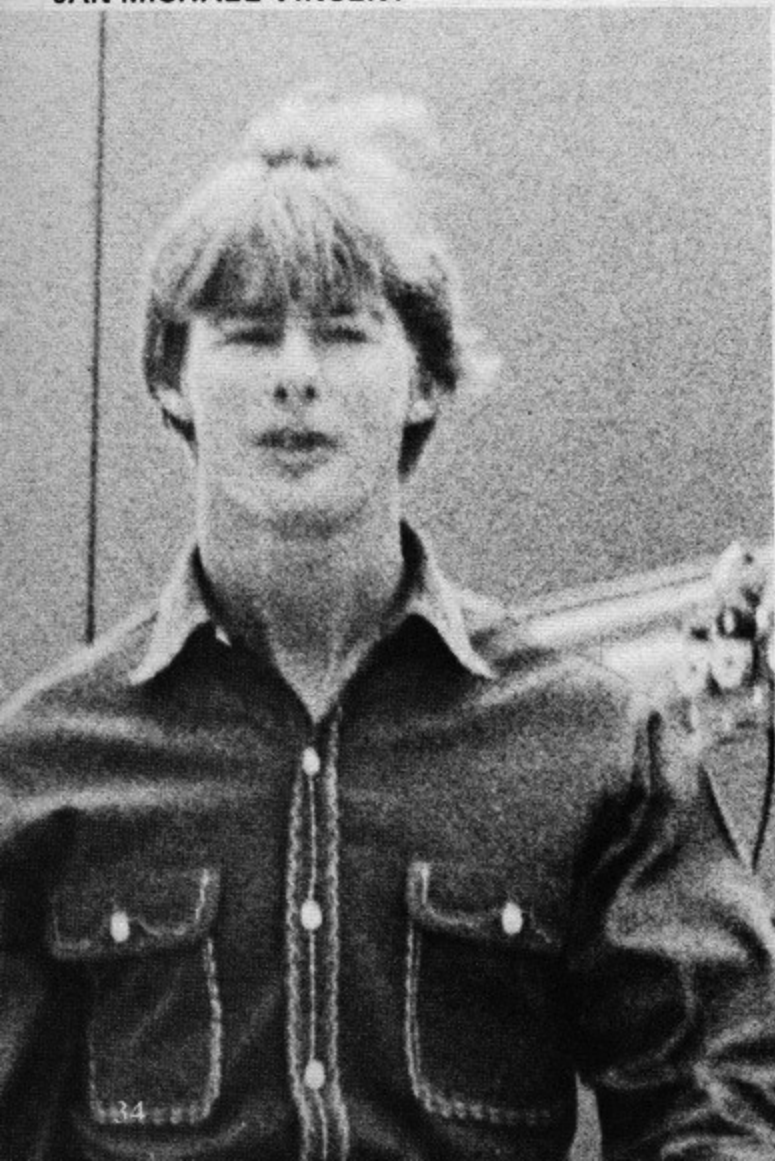


FLASHES... FLASHES...
