like Danny and Jeremy and Suzanne around, everyone has to be a little extra careful!

After the scene is completed, the Family races over to their personal director chairs or dressing room trailers for a few minutes of well-deserved rest. There are times they're on their feet all day, from early morning until after the sun sets, so break time is a welcome change. Susan might be curled up with a book . . . she never gets enough time to catch up on her reading. David could be thinking about what he felt was wrong with his scene, and how he could improve his performances the next time.

"The only good actor is one who learns from his mistakes," he says.

Rest time is never long enough, because there's another scene to shoot before lunch. Most days, the school-age Partridges get sufficient time for their studies. The director will shoot a scene involving the older family members while Suzanne, Jeremy and Danny head off to crack the books. Suzanne might have a smile on her face . . . she loves school, and is a good student. But the boys might look a bit happier if they were going to play football!

Lunchtime finally arrives, and everyone scoots off to the cafeteria. Susan keeps her great figure by ordering a salad, but David can't seem to resist that luscious-looking piece of fudge cake! (He'll work it off, though, with a busy afternoon schedule.)

Before the afternoon scenes can be filmed, a change of clothes and general freshening up is called for. Soon we see a bunch of refreshed-looking Partridges ready to go again.

Everyone's looking forward to the afternoon shooting because the Partridges will be practicing a musical number and they all love to film that—especially David. Often, the music will have already been recorded, and the Family will sing along to a tape. That's the case today, so time is saved and an extra scene can be squeezed in.

Lots of scenes call for extras, and sometimes fans who have been waiting to see the Partridges all day may be
