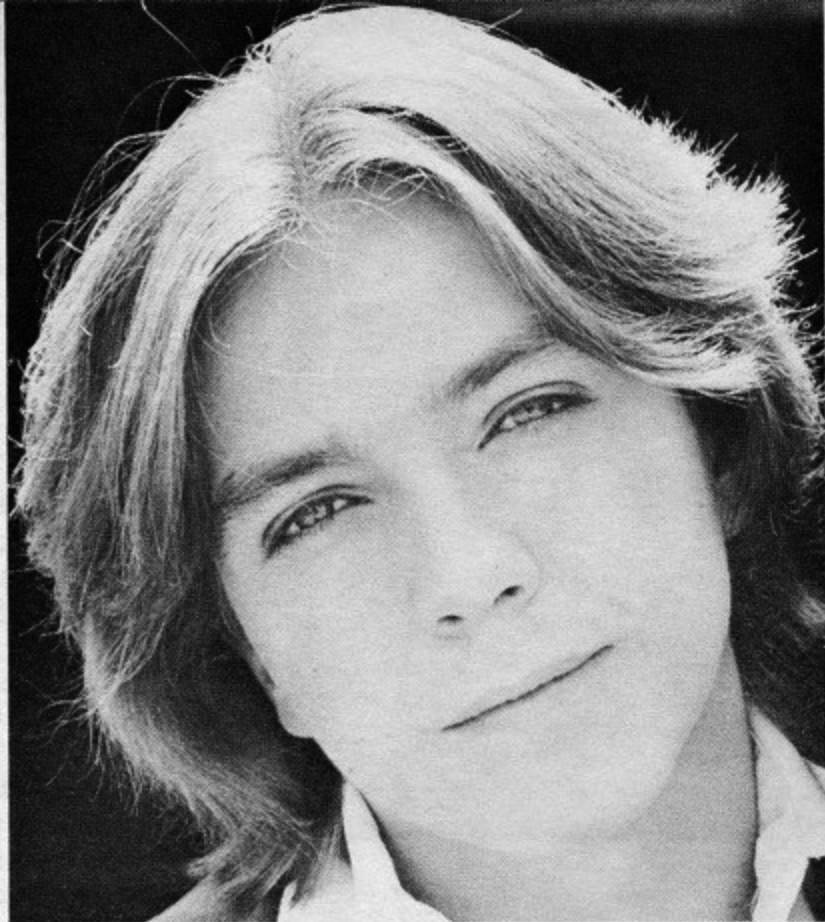


ANSWERS TO DAVID'S KISS QUIZ



Well, how'd you make out? Compare the answers you checked on Page 34 to the answers here and find out if you passed *David's Kiss Quiz*! If you got more than five answers right—well, don't worry girl, you're on your way! If you got more than eight answers right, chances are when and if you meet David that you'll set his heart a-thumpin'! If you got ten or more answers right, wow—watch out, cos you're a real "David Cassidy type of girl"! If you got every single answer right—just keep your fingers crossed and hope that one day you'll meet adorable David Cassidy, cos you're just the kind of girl he's looking for!!

Question 1: If you answered **NO** to this question, you have the correct answer. Though David is usually not demonstrative in public—if he likes a girl, his impulse is to want to reach out and reassuringly hold her hand or touch her once in awhile. David feels that a girl should be able to respond to this without thinking he is being fresh.

Question 2: If you answered **NO** to this question, your answer is correct. The answer to this question (and the one following) ties in with David's feelings mentioned in the answer above.

Question 3: If you answered this question **NO**, your answer is correct. The last thing in the world David would want to do is upset or embarrass a girl, or do something she would object to. However, if he felt in his heart that to reach over and give her a little kiss was just the right thing to do—then he would want to do it without feeling guilty about it.

Question 4: If you answered **YES** to this question, the answer is correct. For an explanation, see the answer to Question 5.

Question 5: If you answered **NO** to this one, the answer is correct. Though—in some areas—David (like any guy) loves a mystery, when it comes to where he stands with a girl, he wants to be pretty sure of how she feels. There's nothing that embarrasses David more than to *think* a girl really wants to kiss him, reach out and start to kiss her—and then find out that he's made a great mistake and that she *definitely* objects to being kissed by him.

Question 6: If you answered **NO** to this question, your answer is correct. David—who is a very moralistic fellow in his own right—has a great respect for anyone's ethics. If you feel a kiss on the first date is improper, you can say so—or indicate so by your gestures and actions—and David will respect you for that.

Question 7: If you answered **YES** to this question, your answer is correct. For an explanation, see the answer to Question 6.

Question 8: If you answered **YES** to this question—well, by David's standards, your answer is incorrect. Though David would love to give you a light kiss on the forehead or cheek during the course of the evening, when you are finally at the doorway together, he prefers either a *real* kiss—or none at all.

Question 9: If you answered **YES** to this question, your answer is correct.

Question 10: If you answered **YES** to this question, your answer—again, by David's standards—is incorrect. Though David (like any guy) probably wouldn't *resist* a prolonged good-night kiss, in his heart he feels that something like *that* is important enough to wait for and will actually be more meaningful and thrilling if he is given future dates to look forward to that kind of kiss.

Question 11: If you answered **NO** to this question, your answer is correct—for David sometimes feels that a good-night kiss on the first date is inappropriate. It's just his particular sensitivity to either your shyness (not to mention his *own* shyness!) or to your reservations about the morality of kissing on the first date. Whatever, if you don't kiss David good-night on the first date, and he doesn't kiss you good-night, don't worry about it—chances are nine out of ten that he will be coming back for more!

Question 12: If you answered **YES** to this question, your answer is correct, for though David would never force himself on you and he would be sensitive enough to respect your wishes (whether you spoke them or just indicated them), if he felt that you really did want to share one of his kisses—well, he would be genuinely happy.
