Before I do—I'll take one last look around.*

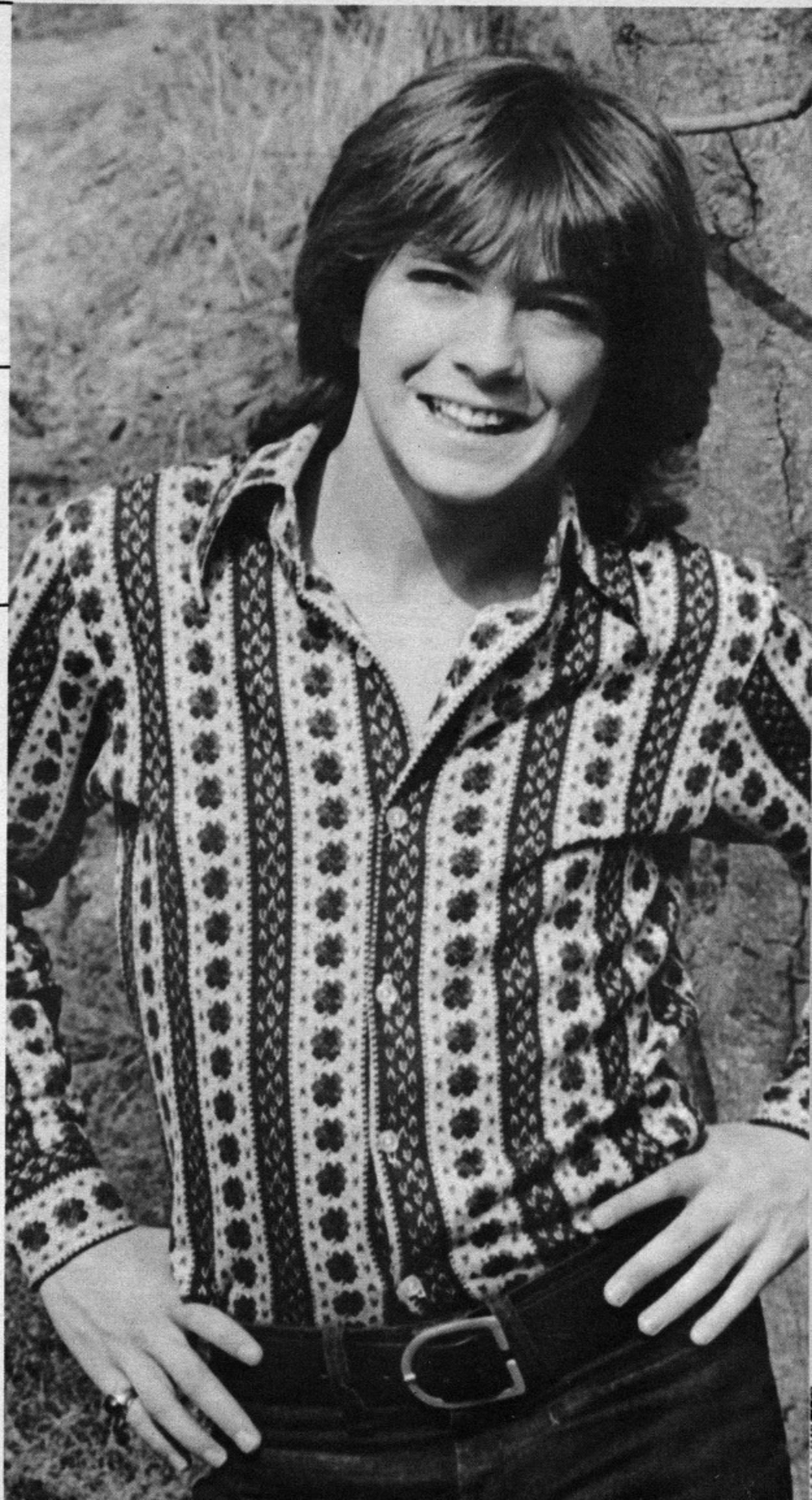
(REPEAT CHORUS)
