DAVID DROPS IN

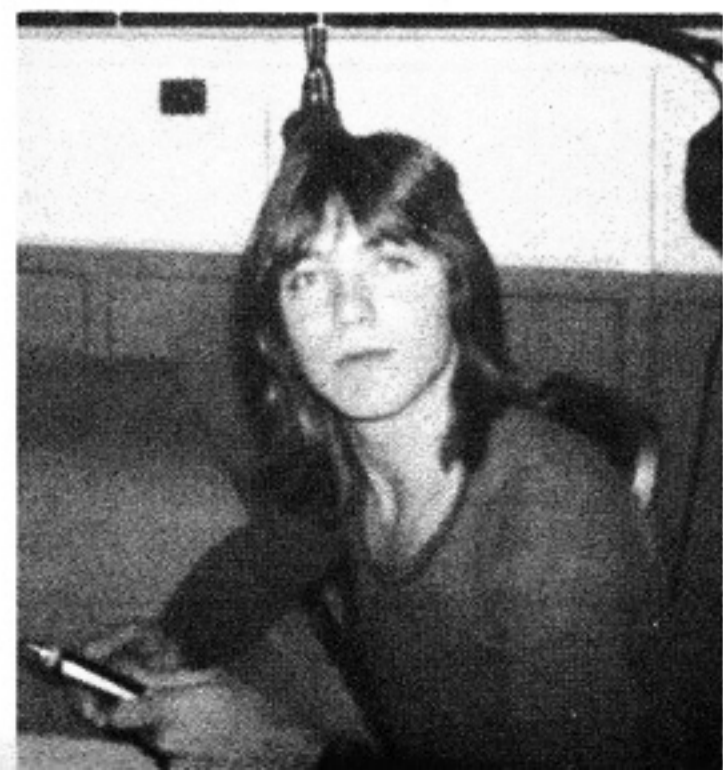
Dear Miss Stavers,

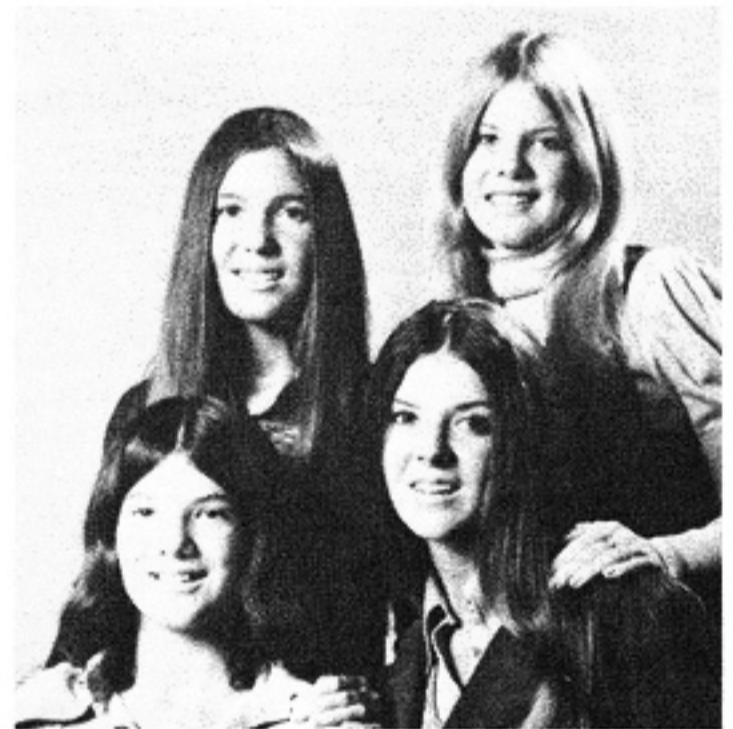
