But this part of your family's vacation is the most exciting for you—cos your folks have come all the way to this town just so you can see David Cassidy in a live in-person concert! And, boy—are you happy!!

"Hello"—you suddenly hear a familiar-sounding masculine voice say, and you quickly turn. All at once, you find yourself looking into two sparkling hazel eyes. The boy is lying on his tummy in a hammock near the pool.

He's peeking through the hammock ropes and looking in your direction—with a big smile on his face!

Your heart skips exactly 8700 beats—cos the boy who's looking at you looks exactly like David Bruce Cassidy! And, as a matter of fact, he is!!

DAVID ON TOUR

All of that *may* sound like a dream—but it isn't! More than one lucky young teener has been able to meet David Cassidy simply by being in the *right place* at the *right time*. If you'd like to be one of these super-fortunate young ladies, here are a few helpful hints to aid you in your unending quest to one day meet David Cassidy!

1. Where he stays. When David is on the road—which he is going to be every weekend this summer—he usually stays at a motel, and usually it's a Holiday or Ramada Inn. If he's in a super-big city, where there are no motels near the arena or auditorium where he is scheduled to perform, he will most likely stay at the hotel nearest to the arena. So using the *David Cassidy Tour Schedule*, on page 3 as your guide, you should be able to figure out where David will be staying in nearly every town he visits.

2. Where does he eat? If David is giving two shows, he usually has a snack between shows in the coffee shop or the dining room of the motel or hotel where he's staying. If he is only giving one show, he most likely will arrive in the town or city where he is to perform three to five hours ahead of time. He usually does a quick run-through rehearsal in the place where he will be giving his concert and then he goes back to his hotel or motel to eat. If there's a swimming pool (preferably an outdoor one) at the place where he's staying, you can bet your bathing cap that adorable David will either be in the water for a dip—or lolling about poolside, taking in a little sun!

HOW TO MEET DAVID IN HOLLYWOOD

Of course, David isn't *always* on the road. In fact, he spends most of his time in a great big movie studio at the Columbia Ranch at 3701 Oak Street in Burbank, California. David's *Partridge Family* series weekly shooting schedule will continue until August 11th. That means that most days, from 7 A.M. to 7 P.M., you'll find David in Studio 21 at the Columbia Ranch.

From August 11th to September 11th, David and the *PF* gang will be on *hiatus* (which is television talk for *vacation*). On September 11th, *The Partridge Family* resumes shooting at the Columbia Ranch and filming will continue until November 24th. Naturally, during David's hiatus, he'll still be doing weekend concerts (see the above-mentioned *Tour Schedule* on page 3).

Most evenings find David Cassidy hard at work in a recording studio at Western Studios, 6000 West Sunset, Los Angeles, California. So, if you really and truly want to meet David Bruce Cassidy, you certainly have a summertime chock-full of opportunities to do so! Happy hunting and good luck!!
