everyone to realize that the "times they are a-changin'" a big Dylan hit of the time.

Born in Minnesota on May 24, 1941, Bob came to New York in 1960 and began playing at coffee houses in the legendary Greenwich Village. It wasn't too soon after that he was discovered—first by the young people and then by Columbia Records. Bob's first album was released in March, 1962. It was just the first in a string of albums that contained some of the most significant songs of the past decade, including "Blowin' In The Wind," which has been called the unofficial anthem of the civil rights movement.

In 1967, Bob was seriously hurt in a motorcycle accident. Because of this, he dropped out of the performing and recording scene to recuperate at his home in Woodstock, New York. He didn't record again until nearly two years later. When that album was released, it sold a million copies in one day. However, Bob stayed away from performing entirely except for an appearance at a benefit dedicated to his idol, the late folksinger, Woody Guthrie, father of Arlo Guthrie. In 1969, he made a public appearance in England, which was his last until his appearance at the Concert for Bangladesh. It was the first time Bob had ever appeared on stage with any Beatle, although Bob knows all of them quite well.

So you see that concert, held at Madison Square Garden in New York City on August 1, 1971, was an historical event! The giants of popular music, led by George, Ringo and Bob not only performed together, but gave their services for nothing. All the money was for charity. This event proved overwhelmingly that contrary to many so-called expert opinions, pop music was not dead. It was alive and well and absolutely thriving. Not only that—these people, as represented by George, Ringo and Bob, were willing to assume responsibility in a troubled world!
