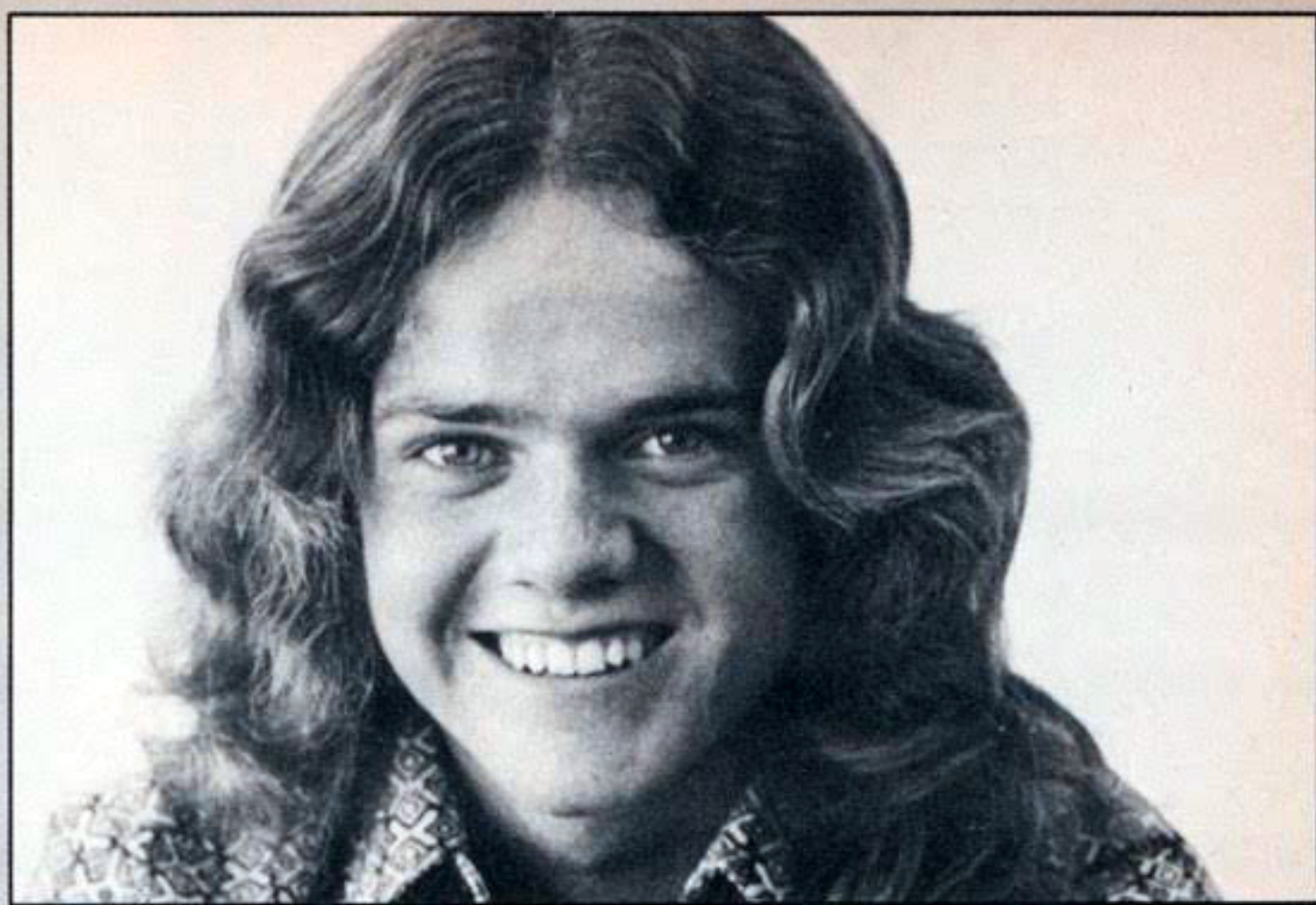


ing and starring in a film about Dracula in Europe, has had (of all things!) a furniture design store for a year. The only things he's made and sold are two tables made from
