

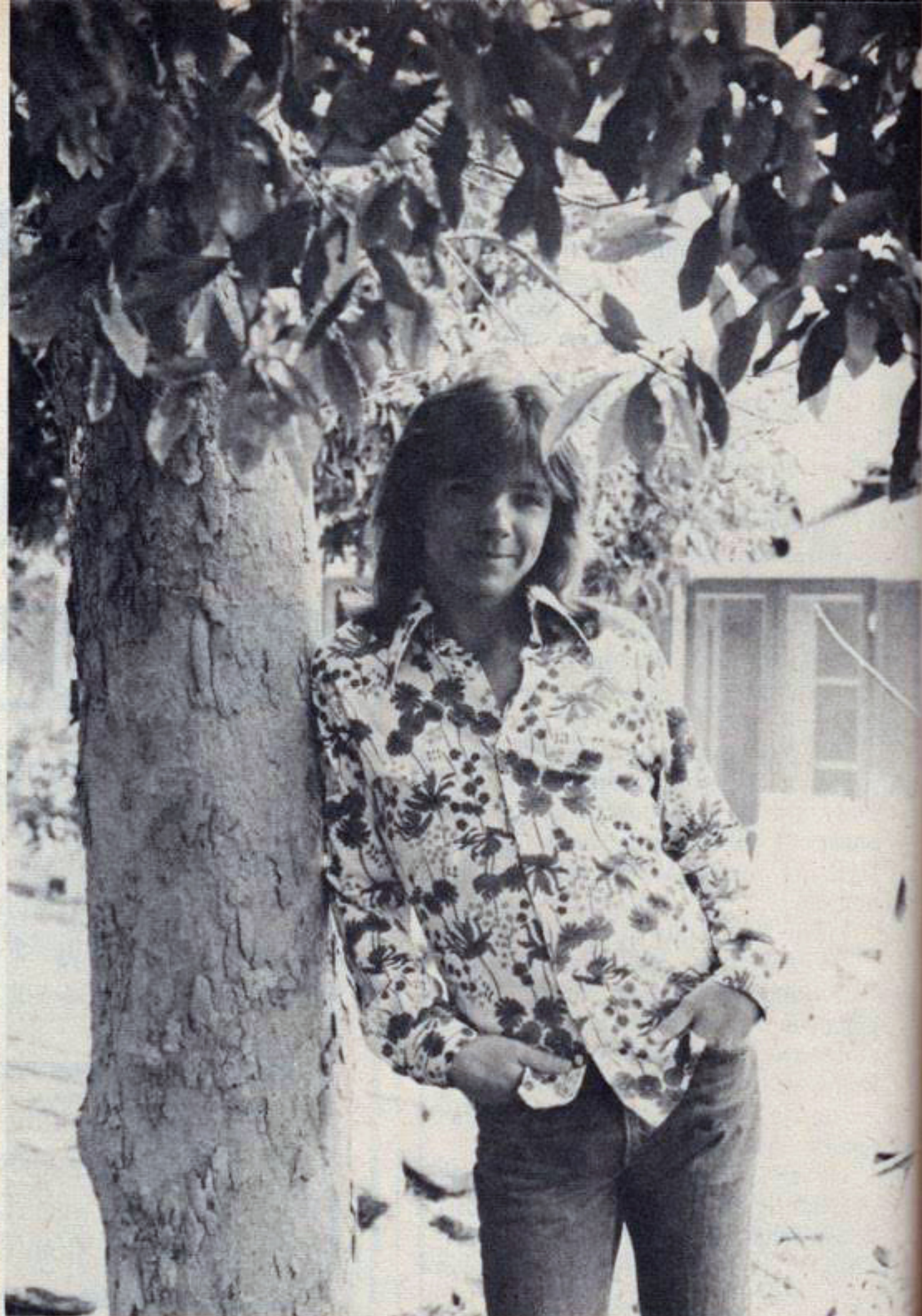
DAVID: MY OO WORST MISTAKES!
