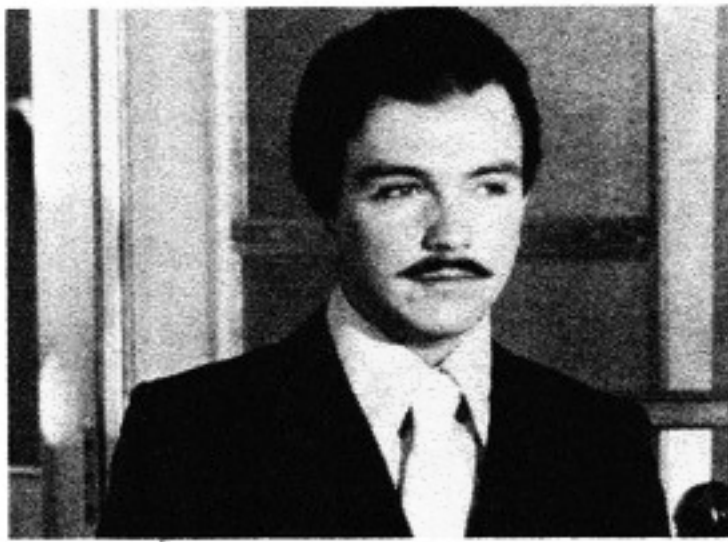


# SPEC SPEAK-IN
