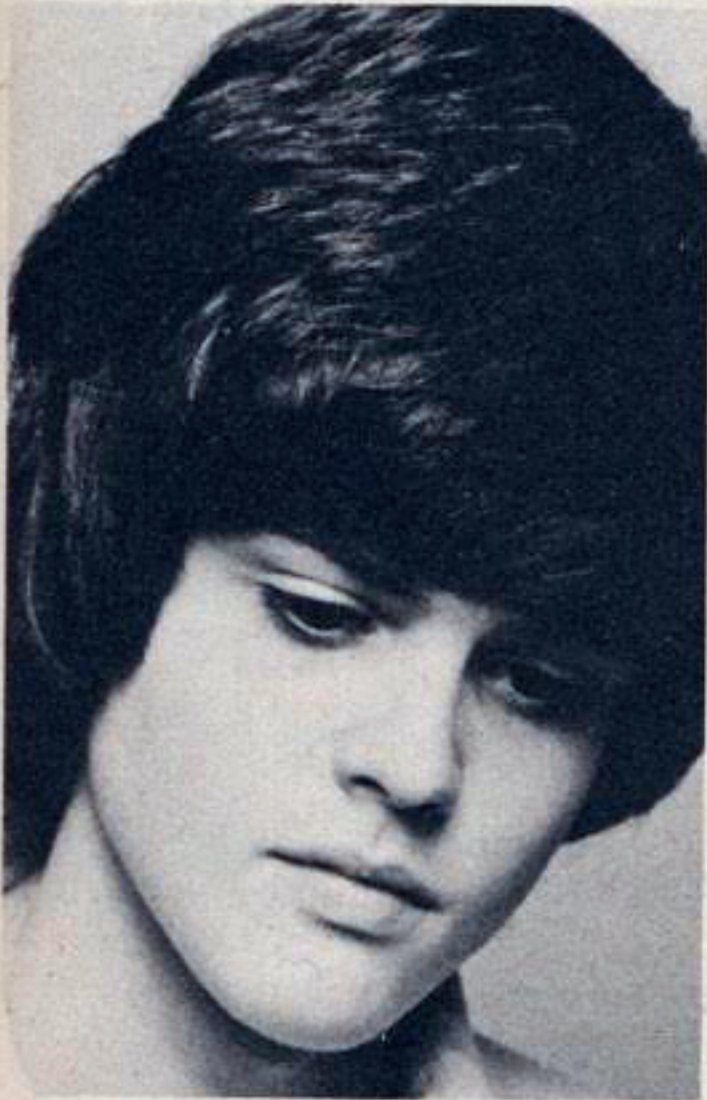

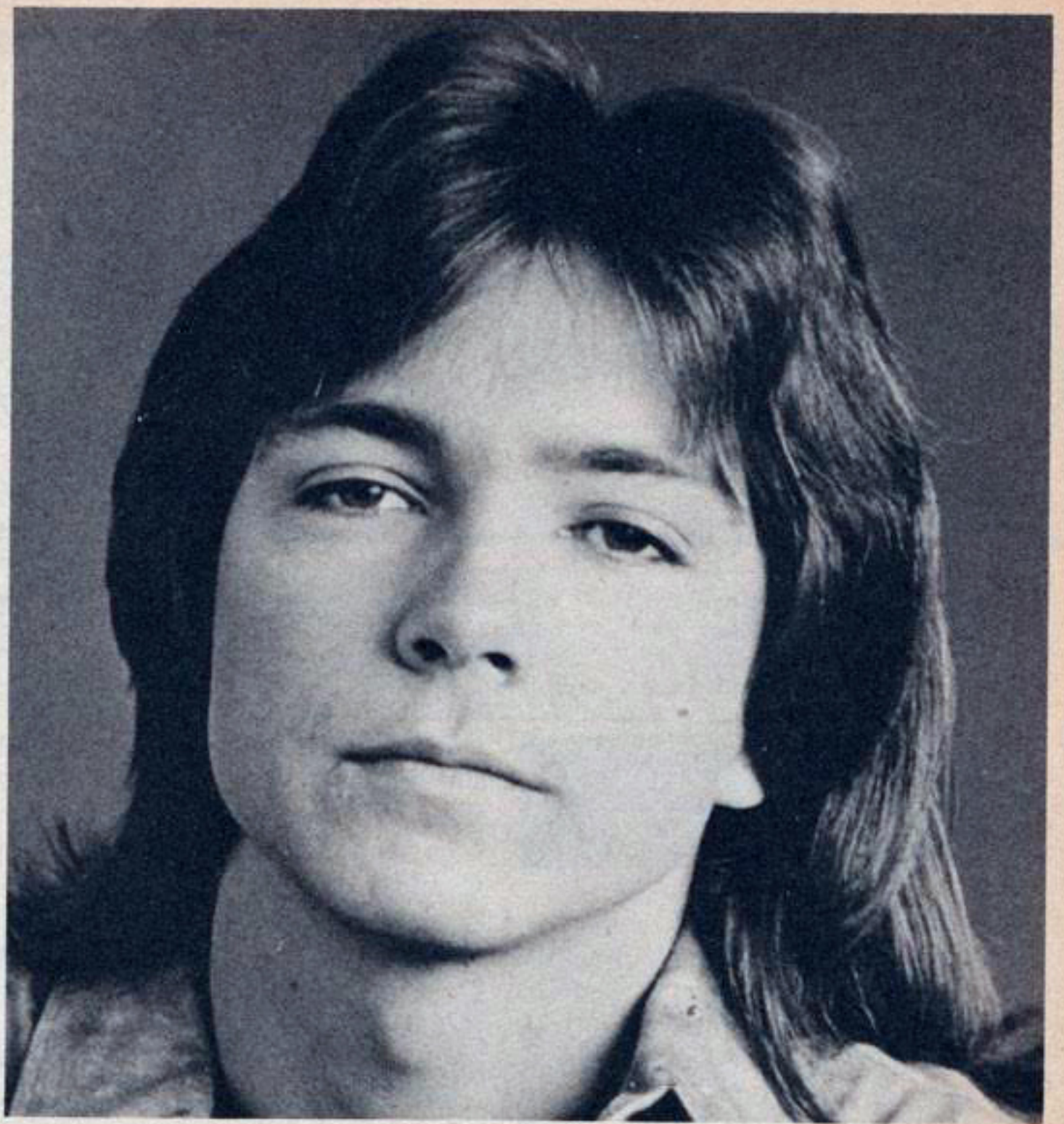
And that's exactly what Donny and David were afraid of. They were afraid that this would happen because it's happened before to many other recording artists.
