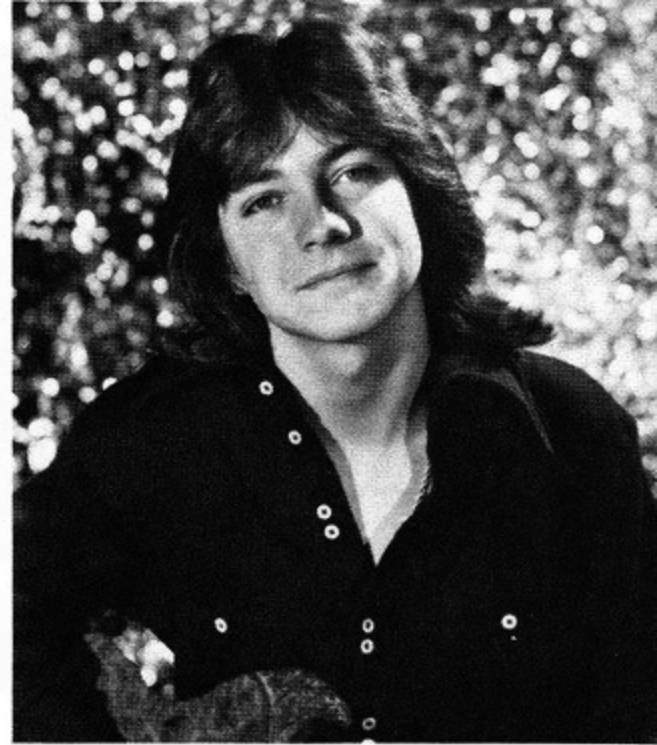
15 Learn to talk with your eyes.
