• BEST SINGLES

Tony Orlando and Dawn: "STEPPIN' OUT." This new release by the fabulous Tony is another sure smash for the group! It's got a catchy tune and fun lyrics and is the kind of song that will have you singing right along after the first time you hear it! (Bell)

Suzi Quatro: "DEVIL GATE DRIVE." Suzi's got a strong voice and a strong record! Her lively new sort of honky-tonk sounding record seems to be going along with the new trends in music. The record has some live sounds in the background—sort of audience participation! (Bell)

Andy and David Williams: "I DON'T KNOW HOW TO SAY GOODBYE." This one by the twins is a soft, nicely moving ballad about love. The production on the record is really good and the beautiful orchestration in the background makes this sound very distinctive. A & D have harmonious and melodic voices. David Cassidy: "CASSIDY LIVE." This is probably David's best LP. It contains his single "Please, Please Me," which is the old Beatle hit. Cassidy Live, was recorded during a concert in Great Britain, and contains some nice selections. Our favorite is the rock medley which includes "Rock Around the Clock," "Blue Suede Shoes" and "Rock and Roll Music." (Bell)



Raspberries: "STARTING OVER." This is the ideal title for the Raspberries' new album, since two of the group members are also new. Since this is simply an "Oldies" album, all the tunes are the original recordings. Barry White: "CAN'T GET ENOUGH." If you loved Barry's single "Can't Get Enough of Your Love Babe," then his latest LP is definitely for you!
