normal recognition for a star of his status. Enter lifelong UK fan, Sharron Liddle and a team of dedicated fellow fans. Sharron started a Facebook Fundraiser Campaign, with the help of some other fans, to get a memorial placque for David at the Phoenix Theatre in London, where he starred with Clodagh Rodgers and Stephanie Lawrence in a Blood Brothers Tour of the UK, in 1995-1996, from the US version in which he starred with Petula Clark and his brother Shaun Cassidy. The team raised funds of over £1,000 for the Plaque and Dementia UK which was a disease that ran in David's family, while he supported Dementia and Alzheimer's charities. Lamenting the fact that there had been no memorial service for the fans since David died on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2017, Sharron's event was organised to ensure that David's legacy of music and acting talent lives on. The period he spent in the 90's in the West End were known to be some of the happiest times of his career.
