

David Cassidy to Perform During Dane Junior Fair

David Cassidy, the young star of television's "The Partridge Family" has been booked for a concert next month at the Dane County Coliseum.

Cassidy will appear with a 15-piece orchestra in a two-hour show July 17 at 8 p.m., as one of the features of the Dane County Junior Fair.

Mail orders for tickets are currently being taken at the Coliseum ticket center, and open sale will begin June 21 at ticket outlets — Hansen's Meadowood Pharmacy, Hilldale State Bank, Montgomery Ward, and the three Copps Department Stores.

Although the singer was discovered by a mass of TV watchers, the younger generation really found him last year when he made a few TV appearances in feature roles on programs such as "Marcus Welby," "Ironside," and "Bonanza."

And when he, as an "unknown," made a two-week

promotional tour for "The Partridge Family" before its debut on the home screen, teenagers scrambled to meet him wherever the tour went. His first single, "I Think I Love You," released before "The Partridge Family," series, sold 3.5 million copies, and the first "Partridge Family" album sold more than a million.

In "The Partridge Family," Cassidy is lead singer and plays guitar in the family's musical combo. Off-screen, he also plays the drums, and he composes both music and lyrics.
