is able to combine acting with another love — music. In the role of "Keith Partridge" he is lead singer and plays the guitar in the family's musical combo. Oif-screen, David, a natural musician, also plays the drums and guitar.

His first single for Bell Records, "I Think I Love You," released before the debut of "The Partridge Family" series, sold 3.5 million copies, followed soon by the first "Partridge Family" album which sold over one million copies.

His second single, "Doesp't Somebody Want To Be Wanted," topped the million sales mark four weeks after being released. The second album, "Up To Date," sold over one million in three weeks.
