

# Bike-a-Thon Scheduled In Crawford County

BUCYRUS — Bicycle riders in Crawford County will join TV's Partridge Family in the American Cancer Society's first National Bike - A - Thon on Oct. 18, according to Harry Wells of Bucyrus, the County Crusade Chairman of the Crawford County Unit of the American Cancer Society.

Members of the Partridge Family, including Shirley Jones and David Cassidy, will be bike - riding in many cities along with many people throughout the country who will be riding for dollars to help fight cancer, Wells said.

The money will be pledged in advance by sponsors recruited by each bike rider. In some cases, the cyclists themselves will contribute so much for every mile they pedal.

A 39 mile course has been routed in Crawford County with starting points at Galton, Bucyrus, Crestline, North Robinson and New Winchester. Riders can stay on the course as long as they wish.
