

Cricket And Pops On True Pitch

David Cassidy followers will not be able to get near the cricket pitch at Eden Park when the American singer performs there on Tuesday, February 28.

Mr Simon Dickie, a tour manager for Harry M. Miller Attractions, said a fence would probably extend from the stage, which will front stands Nos 5 to 7, to the sides of the ground. Security guards would be stationed behind the fence.

"The cricket pitch will be roped off anyway," he said.

When Cassidy and his entourage arrived at the ground they would travel behind the Rugby dead-ball line.

The entire rear half of the playing field would be kept completely clear, as the Eden Park Board had asked, Mr Dickie said.

"Cricket fans," he said, "can be assured that every precaution will be taken to give a good concert and to ensure that the pitch is looked after."
