

Cassidy coming

David Cassidy, famous at the age of 23 for his acting in "The Partridge Family" and his million-selling recordings, is expected to draw a crowd of more than 15,000 when he appears at Eden Park next month.

He will be the first pop artist to perform at Auckland's major sports ground.

Cassidy who has been described as wearing crowds, clamour and adoration like a five o'clock shadow, uses private jets and helicopters to avoid mob scenes by his teenage fans.

His first single, released in August, 1970, featuring as lead vocal in the Partridge Family, "I think I love you," went on to sell over five million copies and is still selling.

Another big hit was "Cherish" which quickly "went gold," (indicative of sales reaching \$1 million or more.)

Cassidy will be appearing at 1.30 p.m. on February 26 and is expected to be on stage for the full length of his 90-minute show.
