



When David Cassidy, The American pop singer, appeared at the Melbourne cricket ground in concert Sunday night, a semi-riot broke out and about 350 teen-agers, most of them female, had to be treated for minor injuries and hysteria. Many of the casualties were pressed against steel crush barriers when screaming fans surged toward the stage. Fainting teenyboppers had to be passed over the heads of the crowd to first aid stations, while others suffered cuts and bruises and broken bones.
