

David Cassidy 'hazard'

MELBOURNE, Australia (UPI) — Victoria State Health Minister Alan Scanlan complained Tuesday that singer David Cassidy "must be viewed as a health hazard" in view of what happened at a concert at a cricket stadium Sunday.

Scanlan reacted after a report on the concert by the Public Health Commission which said 300 teenagers fainted and another 50 were injured in the crowd of 30,000.

"In such conditions as existed at his performance at the Melbourne Cricket Ground on Sunday, David Cassidy must be viewed as a health hazard," Scanlan said.
