People at his funeral Wednesday laughed and applauded and, said actor Dennis Weaver, "It was very unusual because it was very uplifting."

"People got up and spoke in very intimate terms about their experience with Jack. It was on a level where everybody kind of laughed," Weaver said.

CASSIDY, 49, died Sunday in a fire that gutted his penthouse apartment. Among those who spoke at

the nonsectarian funeral was comedian Milton Berle, who remembered Cassidy as an 18 year-old singer when they performed together in the stage production of "Spring in Brazil."

Berle said Cassidy told him once in Boston that the show should have opened in Brazil and closed in Boston.

Singer-dancer Nanette Fabray, who organized the service, remembered Cassidy as a man always modishly dressed, even when he went lishing — in Gucci shoes and belt that matched his fishing pole.
