Certainly everyone in town was expecting wholesale changes in the network's lineup, with Fred Silverman throwing out the weak to make room for shows that have been developed since his move to NBC in June. But Silverman had given his blessing to David's "Man" — and just a few days ago Cassidy had been assured the show would be saved and switched to a new time slot where it would have a chance to build an audience.
