

He may be grown up, but Danny Partridge still needs a big brother

LOS ANGELES (AP) — Former "Partridge Family" stars David Cassidy and Danny Bonaduce will team up at a Sept. 14 concert in Hershey, Pa. — provided Bonaduce is available after he is sentenced on an assault charge.

Cassidy plans to sing Partridge Family hits such as "I Think I Love You" and songs from his solo album, his publicist, Steve Levesque, said Wednesday.

Bonaduce, who played wisecracking little brother Danny Partridge in the ABC series, plans to open the show with a stand-up comedy routine based on his run-in with the law, Levesque said.

If he can make it, that is. He pleaded guilty to endangerment and no contest to assault last month in Phoenix for allegedly attacking a transvestite prostitute. Bonaduce could get up to 22 months in jail at sentencing Aug. 23.

The Hershey concert will launch Cassidy's national tour.
