

# Ex-teen hearthrob is leaving Las Vegas, hitting the road

**LAS VEGAS** — David Cassidy will try his luck on some different projects. His "At the Copa" show in Las Vegas will close Jan. 21, less than a year after its debut.

Cassidy, 50, says he wants to spend more time with his family and pursue offers for a recording contract and a movie. He'll finish the second year of his contract with Harrah's Entertainment by performing concerts at other Harrah's properties. The future of the 10-month-old "At the Copa," a Broadway-styled musical in which Cassidy and Sheena Easton portray nightclub singers, was uncertain after it became apparent last month that Easton would leave the show. Cassidy is producer.
