

David Cassidy bio to hit stores on May first

IN the seventies, David Cassidy was arguably bigger than Elvis.

He was mobbed wherever he went by adoring fans.

David shot to super stardom with the hit TV show *The Partridge Family*, but there was more drama off the screen than on for Cassidy.

Now he has updated his best-selling autobiography with *Could it be Forever*, a brutally frank account of the madness of those years and the tough, often shallow, world of the entertainment industry.

On the way, it explodes the myth of Cassidy being squeaky clean.

In *Could it be Forever* Cassidy reveals all. He reveals the women in his life, the heartbreaking relationship he had with his father, the late actor Jack Cassidy and how he lost everything through financial mismanagement.
