Cassidy in B-test charge

SEVENTIES teen idol
David Cassidy has been
charged with drink-driving after cops allegedly
saw him swerving across
a road in his Mercedes.

Officers said they
watched the singer, now
60, veer across lanes and
a hard shoulder before
cutting up another motor.
They say a search revealed a half-empty bottle of bourbon in his car.
The Partridge Family
star was pulled over in
Florida on Wednesday.
He told officers he had a
glass of wine and a painkiller hours earlier.

A breath test showed
blood alcohol readings of
0.139 and 0.141 — way
above the .08 legal limit.
Cassidy, who became a
pin-up with hits like Daydreamer and How Can I
Be Sure, insisted he was
innocent and vowed to
fight the charges.
