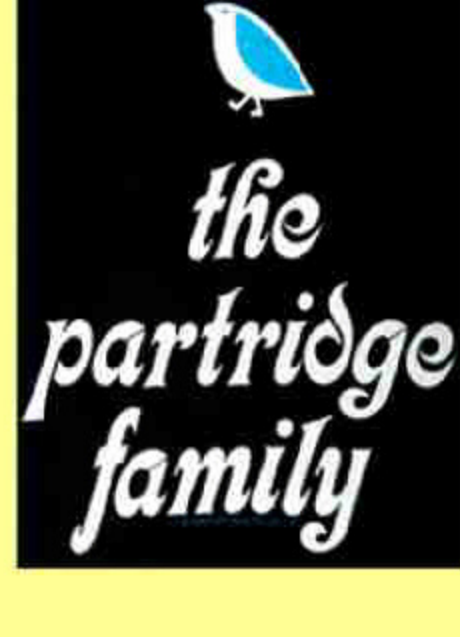




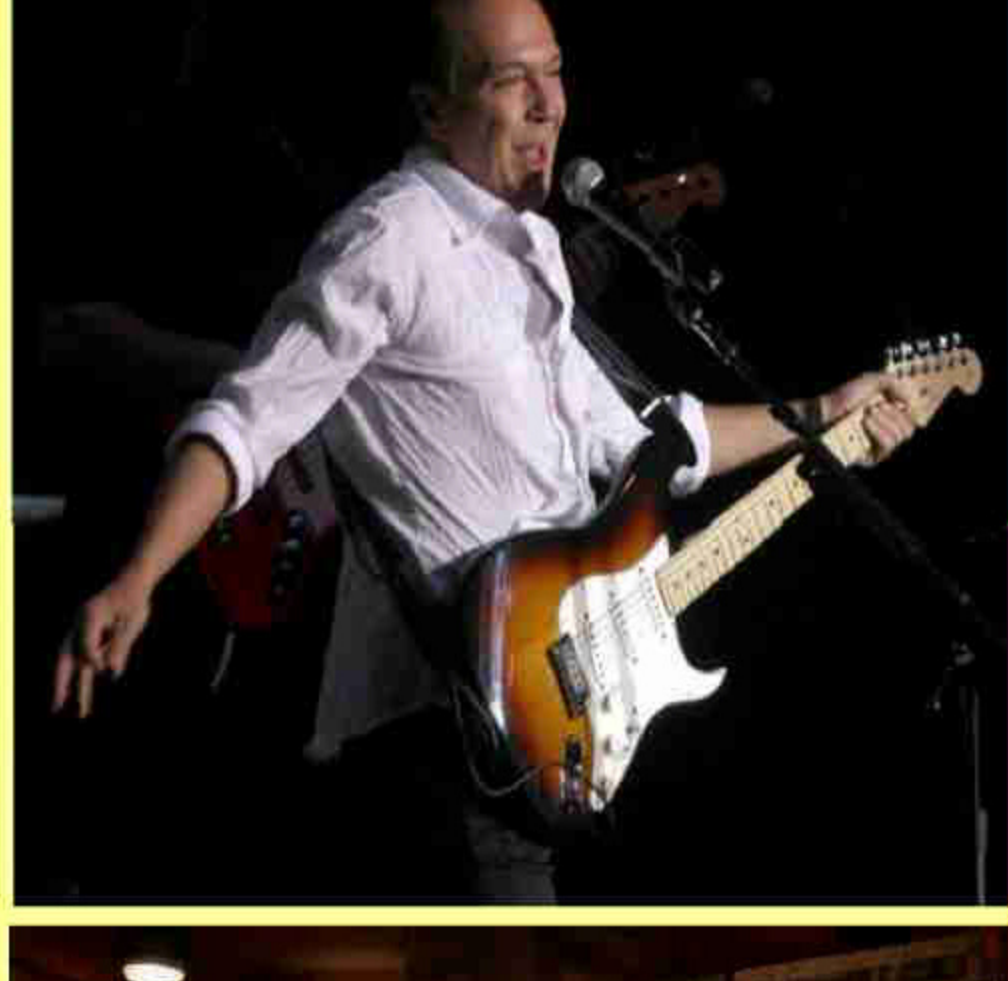
Cassidy embraces the audience with open arms as he starts the concert with his hit "I Can Hear Your Heartbeat."

Excitement reached a fever pitch among the female fans in the first two rows. Cassidy paid them special attention by continually reaching out to the lucky few.

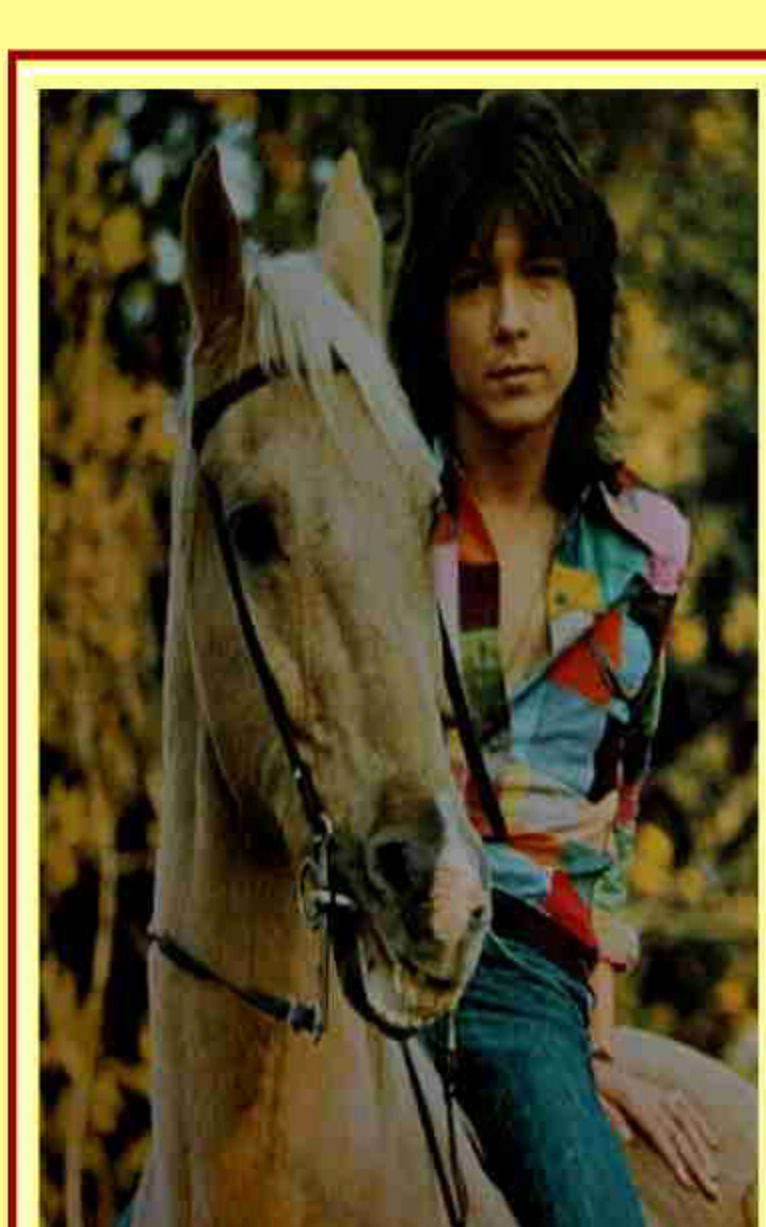

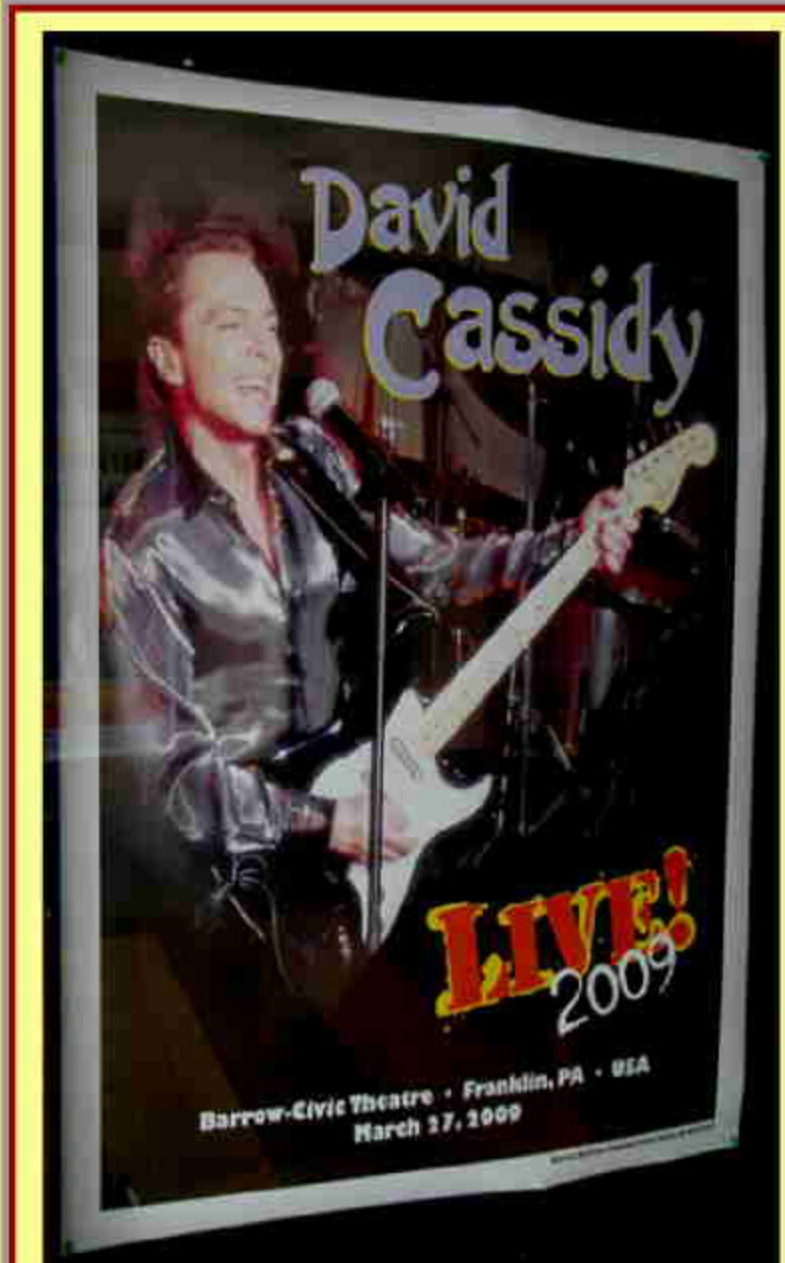
Guitarist Matt Sullivan and David collaborate during a Jimi Hendrix number. Having seen Jimi at age 16, he said he was truly inspired for life.
