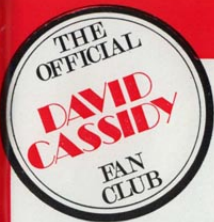
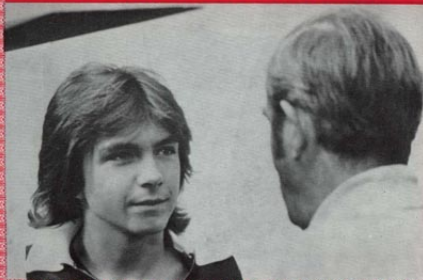


Above: David's director explains a camera angle to him.
