Hi there!

I know it must be a surprise to find me giving you a postal order, but that's exactly what I'm doing, and for a very good reason, too. You see, it has come to my attention that somehow, someway, some of the postal orders that you send to my office, either for fan club memberships or for back issues, or even for posters just aren't arriving.

Now, that reminds me, I've got another issue to raise with those of you who are members of the fan club. It's very important that you send all your newsletter vouchers in one piece. That's the best way to ensure that you receive your newsletter on time.

You see, we order our newsletters in advance from the printer. So that means that if you haven't sent us your voucher, we can't send you a newsletter after we've made our order.

For example, if you send us a voucher for your January/February issue now, we can't send you a January/February newsletter, because we don't have any left. All I can do is to send you a May/June newsletter.

You see, if your postal order isn't made out exactly right, then anyone can go to the post office and exchange your hard-earned postal order for cash. But it's easy to prevent that, if you follow these simple directions.

- (1) On the line where it's printed, if you want a back issue or to join the fan club, print BEAT PUBLICATIONS in block capitals, beside the word PAY, just as it's done above.
- (2) After you've done that, cross the postal order. That just means to draw two parallel lines from the lower left-hand corner to the upper right-hand corner. Between these lines, print & CO., just as it's done on the example above.
