There are plenty of entrances to White City Stadium. The maximum capacity is 60,000, but again, to ensure comfort, the numbers will be limited to 40,000.

Once you enter the stadium, you'll find that whether you're in the stands or the grass area, you'll have equal access to the souvenir booths, which are part of the stadium's general set-up, or the vendors, who will pass through the crowd. Again, the only official souvenirs are on sale inside the stadium.

### SCREENS

At White City Stadium, a special area has been set aside for people in wheel chairs. Again, the Red Cross will be on hand.

Another added attraction at the London concert will be the simultaneous televising of the concerts. Screens will be set up so that, not only will you be able to see David as he performs, but you'll also be able to see a super close-up of him as he performs.

The stage will be at one end of the oval, and it's 12 feet high, so everyone will be able to see, and 80 feet wide, so that David and his band will have plenty of room to ramble. As is also the case in Glasgow the stage will be covered in case it should rain. With all that electrical equipment, this is absolutely vital.

### KNOCK OUT

But rain or shine, absolutely *nothing* will interfere with your view of David no matter which concert you go to.

And no matter which concert you go to, you can be sure of having a good time. Ever since David returned to Los Angeles after his tour "down under", he has been resting and getting his act in shape for us. And it's bound to be a knock out!

Once he arrives, the strictest security precautions will go into effect. But when he's at the concert, he's OURS!!

expense to make certain that both David and us are perfectly safe. To take care of the security, he has hired Artist's Security to supply the body guards.

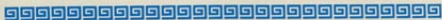
These men are the most experienced bodyguards in the world, and they have provided security for dozens of concerts.
