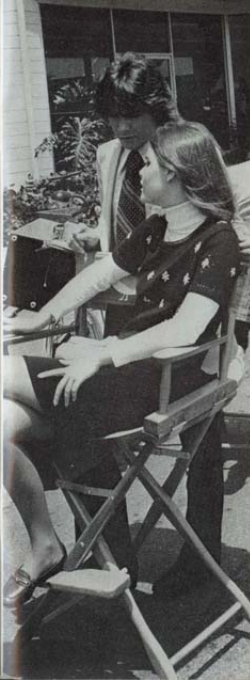
New Release
