escape to Hawaii, the romantic beauty and calm of the islands will soothe a good many of his worries away and help him to face any that still remain.

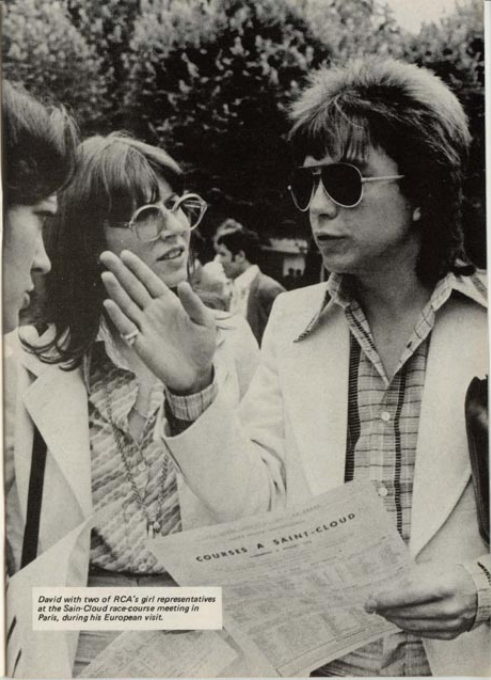
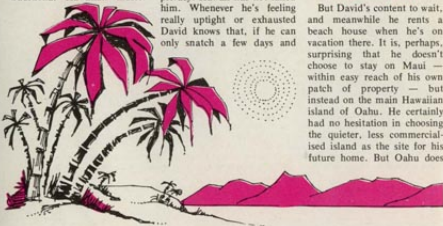
The magic still holds.
