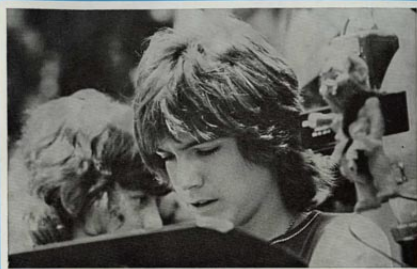
## Green Eyes?
