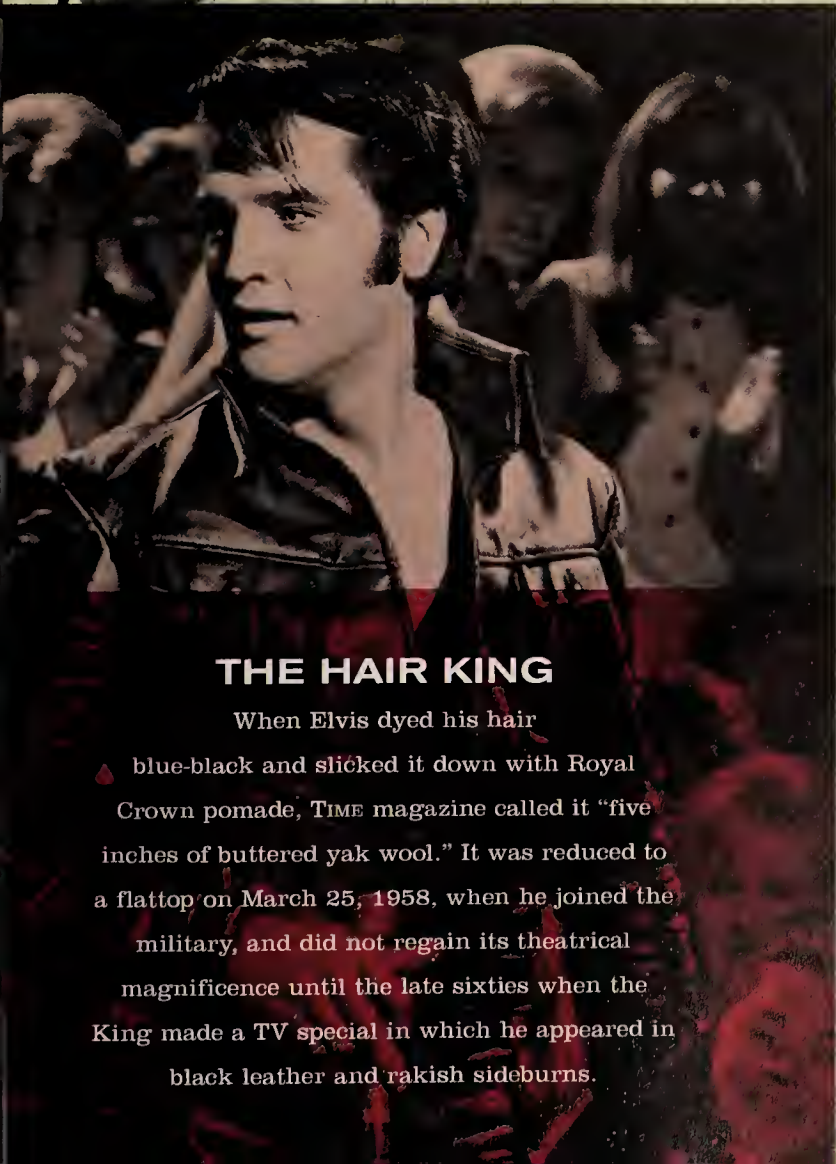


IN 1974, WHEN MY

When Elvis dyed his hair
