DYLAN'S DOUBLE LP!

WILD & LESTER'S NEW FLICK!

HOPE YOU CAUGHT the BEATLES' incisive and fascinating United Artists full-length color documentary movie Let It Be, starring the fab four, of course-who nowadays could be called the fab three, plus one. Let It Be shows the Beatles informally working, talking and making music together. It's like being a "little fly on the ceiling" and looking down and seeing everything that is going on! If you dug the movie, here's good news: United Artists/Apple Records also has the soundtrack—called Let It Be—and it's another beautiful Beatle long-playing record album!

Get a load of Easy Rider co-star JACK NICHOLSON as he looks in Paramount's On A Clear Day You Can See Forever, in which he plays the role of a sitar-playing hippie ... DYLAN-lovers—here's a flash for you! BOB DYLAN has just finished a double LP which could be coming out any minute. It'll be called Self Portrait and the back-up musicians include GEORGE HARRISON, AL KOOPER and DOUG KERSHAW, to name a few. Most of the tunes are (as usual) Dylan originals. One of the tunes on this double set is the EVERLY BROTHERS' famous Let It Be Me. Guaranteed to be a winner! . . . Congrats to handsome CHRISTOPHER PENNOCK and his lovely bride actress MARILYN JOSEPH. They were married early in June in the United Nations Chapel in New York City . . . Also congrats to a couple of OSMONDS — little seven-year-old JIMMY on his big hit record in Japan, My Little Darling, and to WAYNE for getting his pilot's license!

If you're lucky enough to live in or near Kansas City, Missouri, you probably caught beautiful BROWNING BRYANT's summer stock theatre performance as the lead in Tom Sawyer. What's more, Browning has just come up with a brand new RCA LP called One Time In A Million, which happens to include that tune (his latest single) plus eleven other tunes . . . Remember FREDDIE "Boom Boom" CANNON of Palisades Park, Tallahassee Lassie, etc? Well, Freddie's still out there boom-booming and he's got his very own record label, Bazooka. First single on Bazooka Records is Mexico Woman by the COLLECTION-produced by Freddie himself . . . SLY STONE has his own label too. It's called Stone Flower and the first group he has recorded is LITTLE SISTER. Little Sister's Stone Flower single is called You're The One. Give it a listen. . . . And speaking of new record stars, say hello to JOEL VANCE, former publicist who is now recording on the Cadet/Concept label. His first LP is called What I Did On My Summer Vacation—and that ought to be interesting!

Didya' know that handsome young stars DAVID HENESY and DAVID CASSIDY have more in common than their first names? They both have groovy, good-looking actresses for moms! David Henesy's mom JEANNE AVERY has just finished the movie version of a Chekhov play in which she plays a Russian peasant girl—quite a departure from her usual sophisticated "lady-type" roles. David Cassidy's mom—actress EVELYN WARD—has just wound up a starring role in Let's Hear It For Miss America, an off-Broadway avant garde experimental theatre production . . . Though BOBBY SHERMAN still has his magnificent Silvercloud Rolls, he recently acquired a very beautiful, very fast German sportscar. It's a Targa Porsche and it set Bobby back some ten grand . . .
