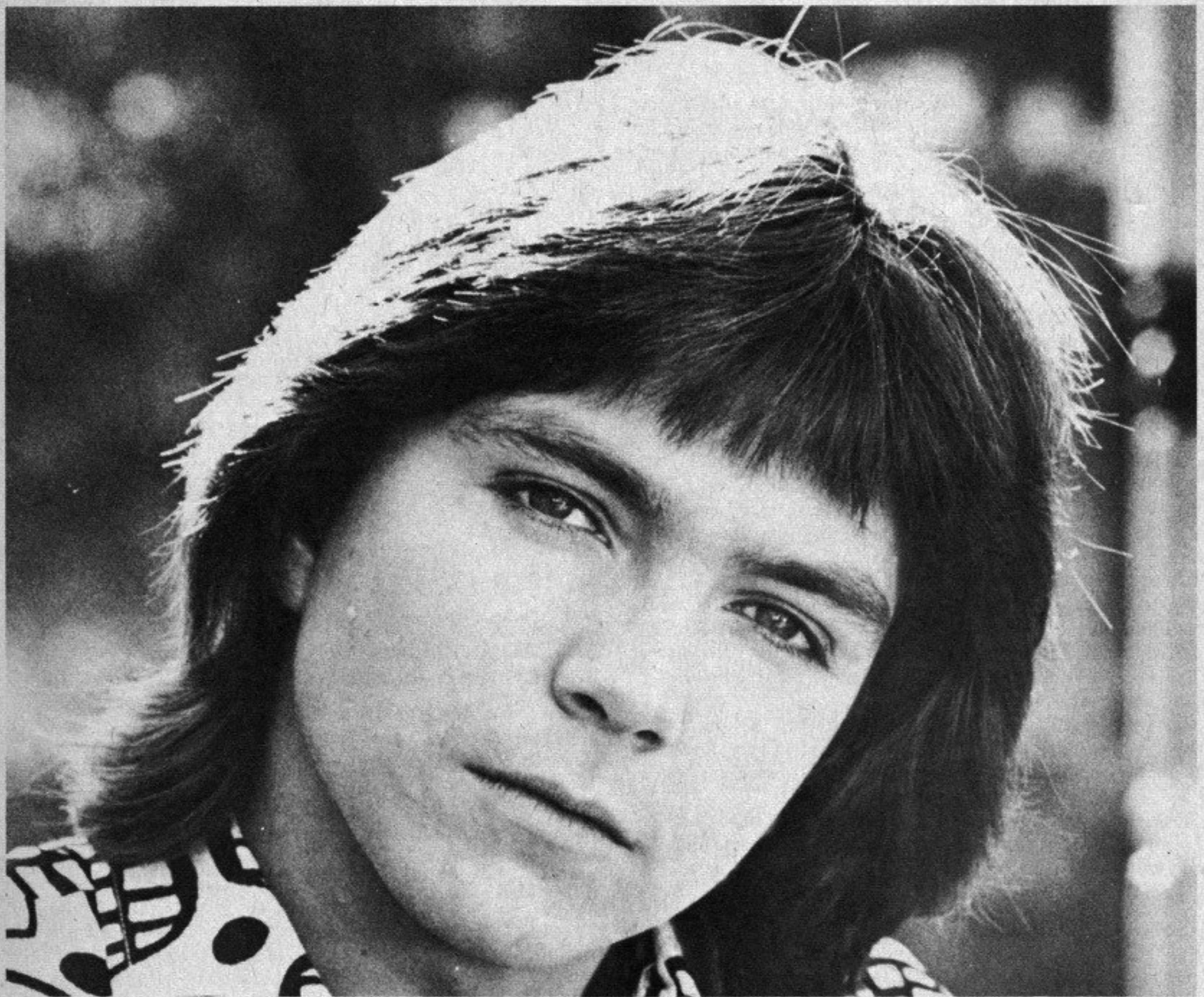


# WHY DAVID CAN'T GO STEADY!
