After meeting you at the Los Angeles airport, you and I took off for the Partridge Family set at Stage 30 (somehow, Stage 29 got printed in the last issue of 16—that's our "special sets" studio and the real stage number for the PF house set is Stage 30) at the Columbia-Screen Gems ranch at Oak Street and Hollywood Way in Burbank, a suburb of Los Angeles.

Thirty minutes after we went into the big, hangar-like, special Partridge Family studio, you met Shirley, Dave Madden, Danny and—of course—David!
