agent whose name I had seen in a fan magazine—in fact, she was Sue Lyon's agent at the time. I called her and she told me to forget it. Instead, I went over and stuck my pictures under her door. The next morning, she called me. . . ."

Robyn spent two years in New York, playing in a soap opera, "Go Where the Heart Is." "I played the heavy," she laughs. "I used to play all sweet young things, but lately I've been playing heavies, which I love. Shirley and Jack Cassidy are happy to find their son so happy with Robyn. Occasionally, she and David will go over to the Cassidys' for dinner. "I love going there," Robyn says. "Shirley is a beautiful, beautiful person—so easy-going. And Jack is really funny."

Robyn, who now lives alone in a Studio City apartment, remains close to her mother and 17-year-old brother. "My family, and particularly my brother, respect David very much," Robyn says. "And I'm always impressed by how much David's close friends respect him."

These close friends, but never the public, often share David's and Robyn's hours together. "We usually just stay home," Robyn repeats. "I have closets full of clothes, but when I'm with David, all I wear are jeans."

It's hard to imagine that *any* girl, no matter how sophisticated, could remain content being a celebrity's girl whom nobody knows. Robyn, however, realizes that to publicize their relationship might hurt David.

"I'm very aware of how dangerous my position is," she stressed. "David is a very hot property right now, so naturally everybody wants to know about me. I guess this could be considered a great opportunity, because publicity is very important to a young actress. But then there is such a thing as publicity which can really hurt you."

"I think David may be getting a little upset about my name being linked with his." The statement came simply, but we could tell Robyn had thought about the possibility of losing David. She knows that if he is to remain a successful teen idol, he has to maintain an image of eligibility.

"I don't want to be shown to the world if it means David will be hurt," she says, and hesitates. "There was a picture of us in *TV Guide* . . . when I saw it, I began to worry . . . 'maybe now he'll tell me to get lost. . . .'"

"But I'm having fun." David's girl brightens. "I have fun with David *now*, and I won't worry about the future."
