The son of actor-singer Jack Cassidy and musical comedy star Evelyn Ward, David was brought up in show business surroundings and finds life as a star much the same as life always has been. Yet he's never taken fame-or his chances for it-for granted. He's always worked hard for what he's gotten and never tried riding to success on the names of his famous parents.

"I knew when I first decided to go into this business I was going to have to do it all on my own," he says. "If that meant I had to work harder, then that was what I was going to do. It just seemed to me it would be a lot more satisfying that way."

Though David admits that seeing his father perform when he was just three years old was the thing that drove him to his career, he also says flatly that his family never pressured him into it.
