other portions are old hat. If you dig Poco, you'll like their latest work. (But I do wish they'd tackle a far out tune and call it "Somethin' Different" 'cause some Poco fans are getting bored.) Lay your ear on "How Down" and "Bad Weather."

ARETHA'S GREATEST HITS—Aretha Franklin—
(Atlantic). If you've missed Aretha's other albums, then this new release should be your pride and joy. Just about all her big ones are on this, funky soul numbers like "A Natural Woman," "Dr. Feelgood" and "Respect." Even "Spanish Harlem" appears here and that's a recent release. Fourteen songs in all.

THE FOUR OF US-John Sebastian-(Reprise). You've had those great little jaunts that you don't ever want to forget and so has John. Maybe they've just been in dreams—like John's-but you get the idea, right? That's what happens on the title tune for his album, and in most of his other material. Very dreamy, very nice. Try out "Apple Hill" and "Well, Well, Well."



SOUL TO SOUL—Original Soundtrack—(Atlantic). I've included this for those of you who stumble into a theater and find yourself cought up with this sometimes bizarre, always rockin' happening filmed in Ghana, West Africa when some of our biggest black stars performed there. Ike and Tina Turner, Roberta Flack, Wilson Pickett.
