Old and it turns new.

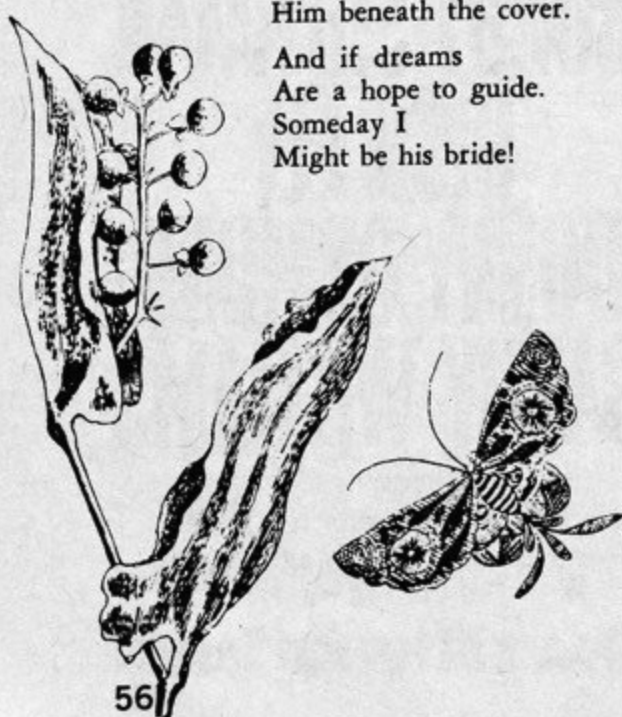
When he sings

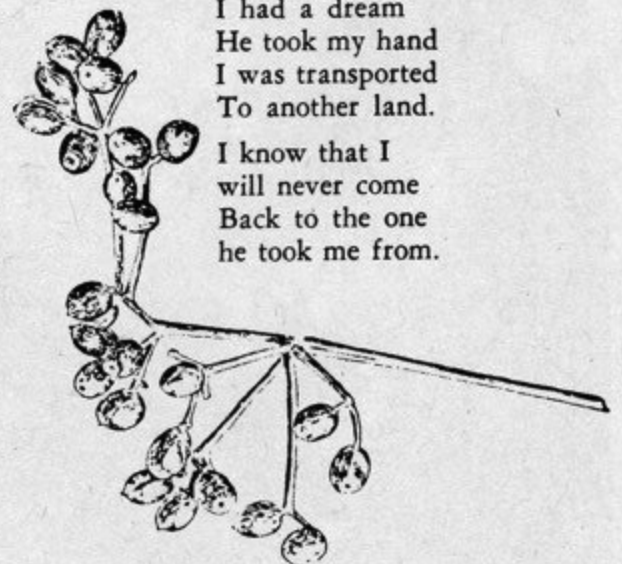
ANOTHER LAND
