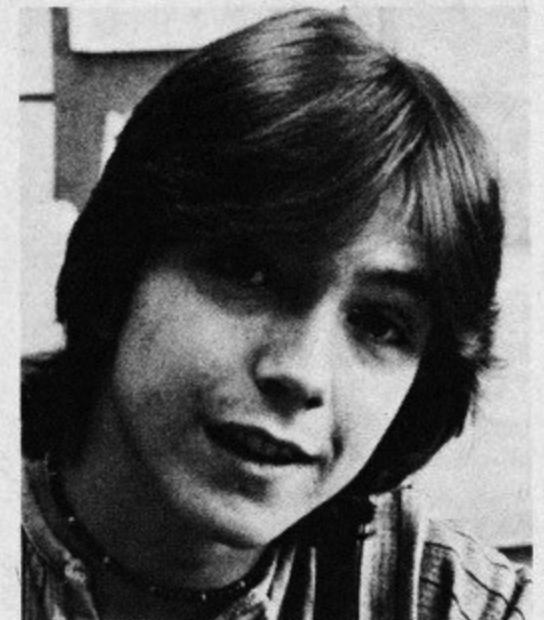
THRILLING PREMIERE NIGHT
