54. SINCE YOUR PARENTS WERE IN SHOW BUSI-NESS WHILE YOU WERE GROWING UP, DID YOU EVER GET SMALL ACTING JOBS THAT WEREN'T WIDELY PUBLICIZED?

There was something, but I usually don't like to talk about it too much! I had my first small part in a little theater on La Cienega where my mom was performing.

55. WHAT DID YOU DO?

We were staging this colonial type show so I had to speak with a Cockney accent. I think my main line was "The coach is waiting, Sir!"

56. SINCE YOU KNEW AT AN EARLY AGE THAT YOU WANTED TO BE AN ENTERTAINER, DID YOU SHARE YOUR FEELINGS WITH YOUR FRIENDS?

Yes, if they were close friends I told them exactly how I felt.

57. DID THEY EVER KID YOU ABOUT WANTING TO BECOME AN ACTOR?

Sometimes they'd joke with me a little, but then I just tease them back about their goals! It was all in fun and no one put anybody down.

58. DID YOU HAVE ANY FRIENDS IN ENTERTAIN-MENT WHILE YOU WERE IN SCHOOL?

A few. I was always exposed to people in show business since my parents were in the profession. I palled around with Sal Mineo, who shared my interest in music, and Jon Provost.

59. DID YOU AND SAL EVER DO ANYTHING TO-GETHER WITH MUSIC?

I'd go to his house quite a bit and we'd jam for hours

60. WHAT INSTRUMENTS DID YOU PLAY?

I loved playing the drums, and Sal had a guitar lying around so we'd fiddle around with that too.

61. SINCE MUSIC PLAYED AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN YOUR LIFE AT THAT TIME, DID YOU THINK OF FORMING A BAND?

I did belong to one for awhile, but nothing too much came of it. We played for school events but nobody was really that serious about performing.

62. SINCE YOU'RE BUSY FILMING AND RECORD-ING, DO YOU HAVE MANY CHANCES TO SEE YOUR YOUNGER BROTHERS?

I try to visit them at least every other week if time permits.

63. WHAT DO YOU USUALLY DO WHEN YOU GO TO THEIR HOUSE?

Ride motorcycles, play football, baseball . . . whatever!

64. WERE YOU EVER KNOWN BY YOUR FRIENDS

AS DAVE OR DAVY?

I've been called Dave by some people, but I've never been known as Davy by anybody!

65. WHEN YOU DECIDED TO GIVE ACTING A TRY, DID YOU WANT TO DO IT INDEPENDENTLY OR GET SOME ASSISTANCE FROM YOUR PARENTS?

I just wanted to do it on my own by starting at the bottom and hopefully working my way up.

66. DID YOU GIVE ANY THOUGHT TO TELEVISION WORK?

No, not in the beginning. I was more concerned with stage work.

67. SINCE YOU'VE HAD SOME EXPERIENCE ON STAGE, WOULD YOU HAVE THE DESIRE TO TRY IT AGAIN?

Very definitely! Performing before a live audience is exciting and rewarding.

68. WHEN YOU AUDITIONED FOR "THE PARTRIDGE FAMILY" DID YOU FEEL YOU HAD FOUND WHAT YOU WERE SEARCHING FOR?

Not quite! I realized the opportunity was great, but in the shows I had done in the past, I played a tougher kid than what the "Partridge" script called for, and I was getting too used to my rough image!

69. BUT WHEN YOU GOT THE PART AND WERE REALLY INVOLVED WITH THE SHOW, DID YOUR OPINION CHANGE?

Oh, yes! It convinced me that being a good guy wasn't so bad after all!

70. DO YOU GET ALONG WELL WITH EVERYBODY ON THE SET?

Yes, they're all great people to work with.

71. IS IT REALLY TRUE THAT YOU AND SHIRLEY WERE UNAWARE OF ONE ANOTHER'S AUDITION FOR THE SHOW AND COINCIDENTALLY MET UP AT THE STUDIO?

It's true all right! Just goes to show you what a small world it is.

72. DO YOU HAVE A FAVORITE SONG OUT OF ALL THOSE YOU'VE RECORDED?

Not really because an equal amount of time and effort has gone into recording all of them.

73. DO YOU BELIEVE IN LOVE AT FIRST SIGHT?

I feel that two people can be very attracted to one another right from the beginning, but love, real love, takes time to grow.

74. WHAT TIME DO YOU LOOK FORWARD TO MOST EACH DAY?

Evening time because that's when I can really unwind.

Not too different than I felt at 20, but at least now I'm recognized as a "legal" adult—which is a groovy feeling for anyone!
