'David hasn't much time for social life," she added, laughing. "You know, David called me about three months ago and said, 'Guess what, Judy! We're engaged! One of the columnists said we're engaged, and we're going to get married at any time if we haven't eloped already!' And we just started laughing. We thought it was hysterical.
