Danny Bonaduce's hair was just as red as it looked on my color TV and Susan Dey was just as pretty as she looked on the screen and in magazines. As I scanned the group, I realized that someone was missing. I didn't see the Partridge Family star David Cassidy — and I wondered where he was!

## MY EMBARRASSING MOMENT

Suddenly, Paul Witt, the producer of the show and a friend and co-worker of mine from Here Come The Brides, walked over to me and introduced me to the young man he had arrived with several minutes before. The young man's name was David Cassidy! I had been looking at David for the past three minutes without recognizing him!!
