A. No, they are not expecting at this time.

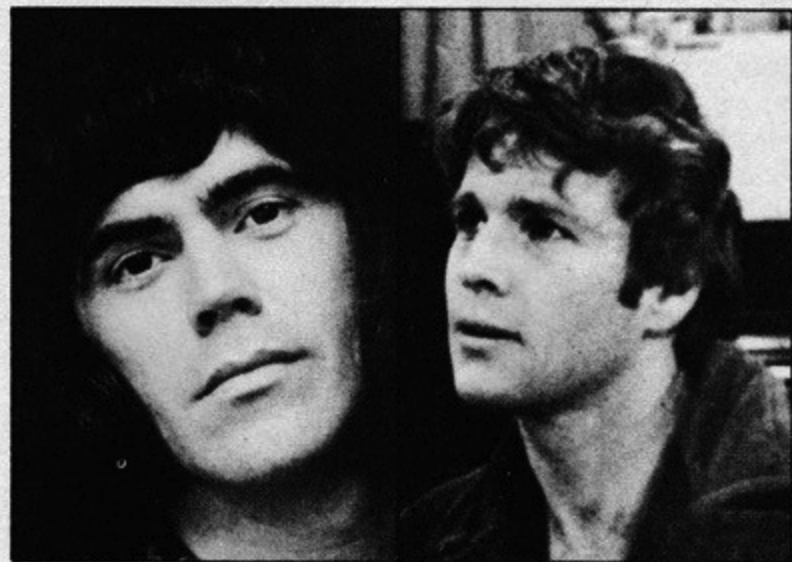
